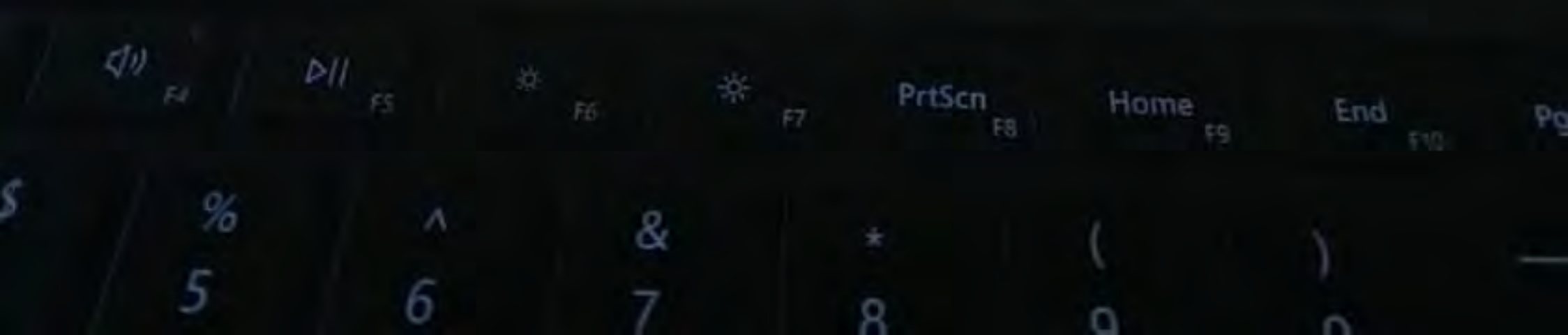

The events at various think tanks, recommended by UB philosophy professors, further broaden their exposure to diverse political and economic theories, fostering critical thinking and debate skills. Overall, this trip not only complements their academic pursuits but also aids in their personal and professional development, offering networking opportunities and a broader perspective on the practical applications of their studies in philosophy, politics, and economics.

The purpose of the four-day trip to Washington D.C. for the University at Buffalo's Philosophy, Politics, and Economics Club is multifaceted. Primarily, it aims to bridge the gap between the academic theory we discuss in our club and the political practice seen in the real world, providing students with a firsthand understanding of how political decisions are made and implemented at the highest levels of government in the world.
